Presidents Message

Let's show our gratitude to the municipality for the use of such a wonderful facility equipped with great equipment, by producing some neat turnings for them to see.

In thinking about the official opening of the Fire hall Facility in June and the visit by Lyle Jamieson, it occurred to me that perhaps we should consider having a raffle that week. In talking to the President of the Golden Horseshoe Woodturner's Guild in Burlington, they have been raffling off a Jet Mini Lathe every few months. With the proceeds from the raffle they have purchased much needed woodturning equipment, including 3 brand new Jet Mini Lathes for their club. I have talked with all of the members of our executive and there is strong support to give this idea a try during Lyle's visit. I have made

inquiries with several woodturning suppliers about the purchase price of a mini lathe and hope to have some costs available for the next meeting.

In an effort to improve the comfort level in the fire hall, my friendly electrician has now installed a fan up in the girders to push rising warm air back down to floor level. Initial tests showed it was very effective. While I had the electrician working on the fan, he also removed the motors from the fan heaters and lubricated them so that they are now a little quieter. This past week I have been approached by members of the Kincardine Medical Clinic Fundraising Committee, to inquire if any of our members would be willing to donate a turning or two, for a fundraising auction for this much needed facility. I was non-committal and said I would raise this with you all at our next meeting.

Please remember members, that your \$35.00 annual membership renewals are due as of 1st of January, so please see Bert our Sec-Treasurer at the next meeting. Your memberships are our main source of revenue and allow us to bring in guest turners to demonstrate for us. Hope to see you all at our next meeting on 19th February at 7.30pm.

Financial Statements Are Here !!!!!

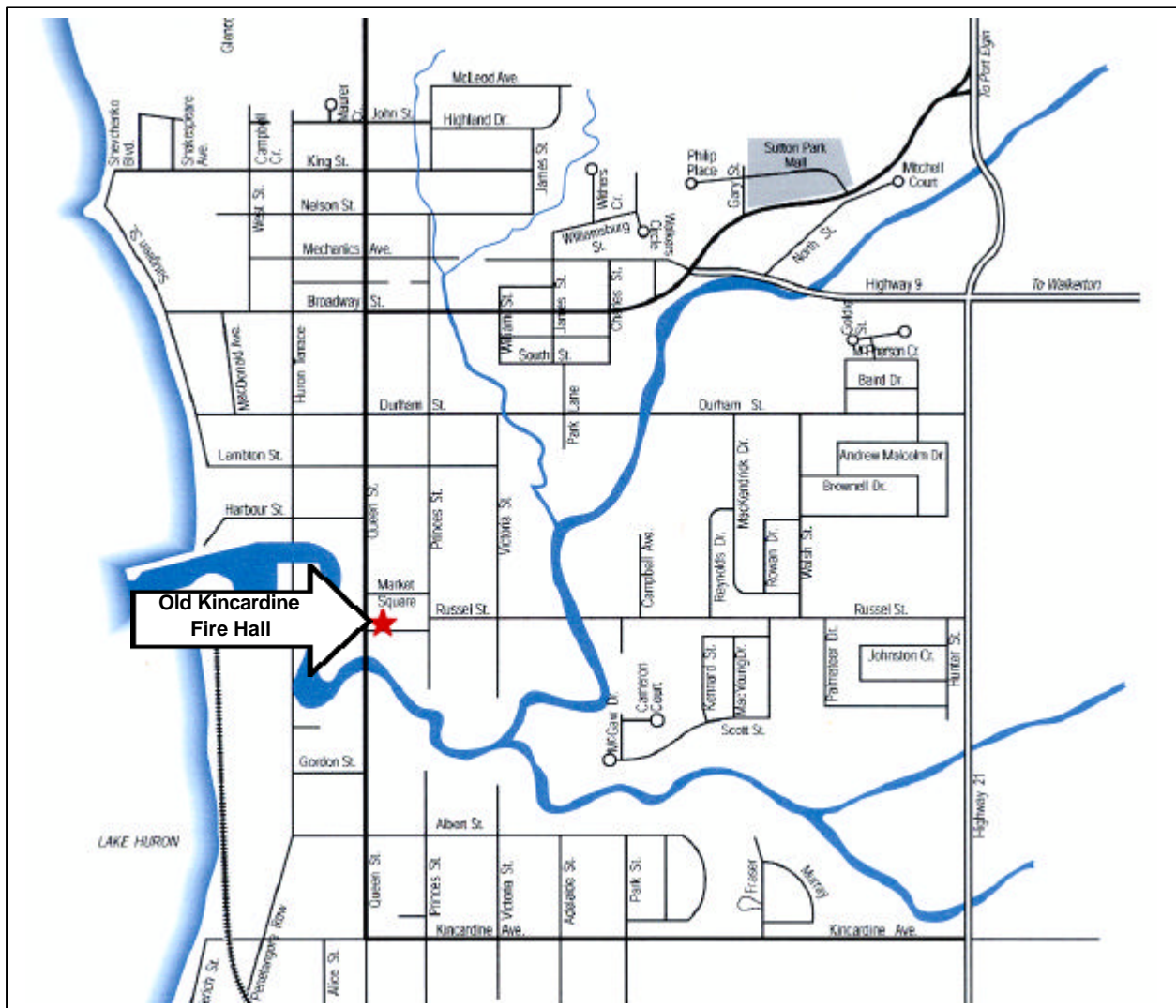
