March: Saturday 22nd.

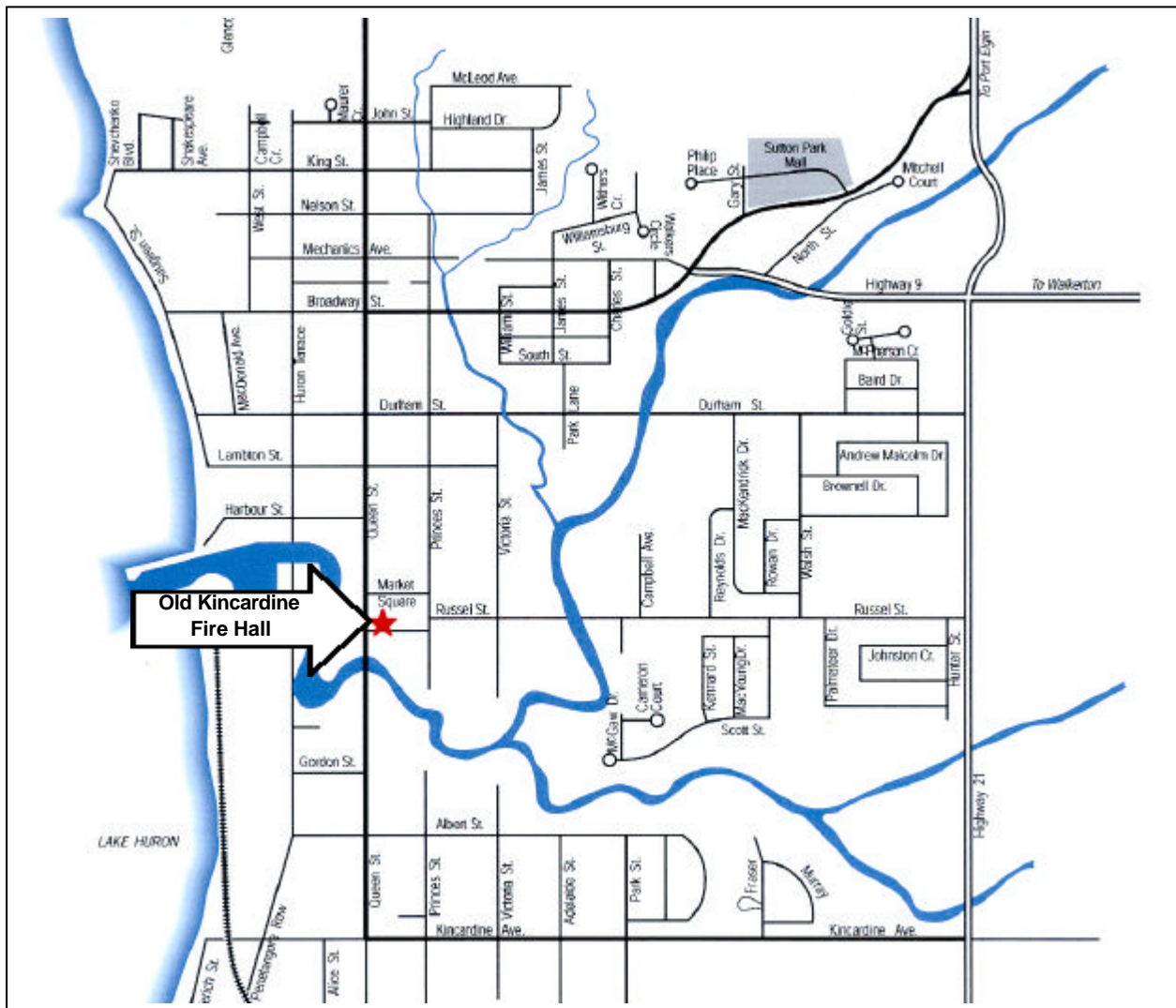
April: Saturday 12th, Saturday 26th is a Demo by Jack de Vos from Australia.
