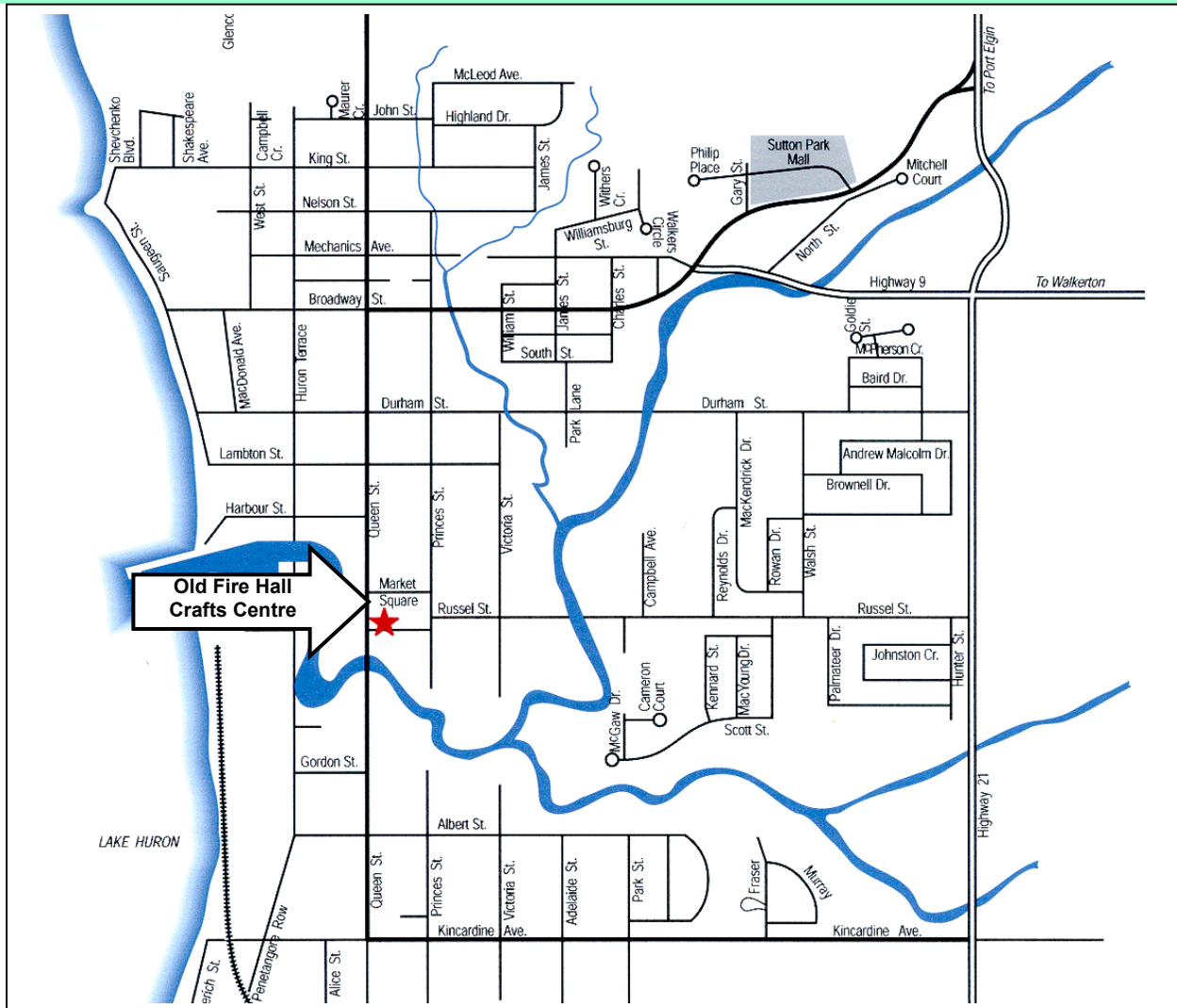
## ANNUAL BAR-B-QUE - JULY 16<sup>TH</sup>
