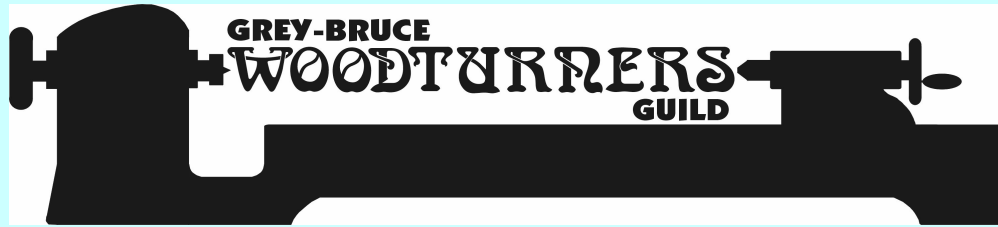

There was not time for a turning demonstration this month but we all thoroughly enjoyed taking the opportunity to view turnings that were brought in for photography. We always learn so much when members describe techniques used and any problems they may have had during completion.

INLACE

Inlace Kits are available in Clear, as well as several colours. There are also additives available such as Nuggets, Granules, Metallic Dusts and Stone Flakes, as well as Metallic, Pearl, and Solid Colour dyes.

A clear or coloured Resin is used either alone or mixed with an additive and when the resin is ready for inlay the hardener is added to the mixture. This can be used to fill in patterns you have carved in the wood or to fill cracks in the wood of your projects. Using black or brown will sometimes camouflage unwanted cracks, metallic or pearl will highlight them and make them very attractive.
