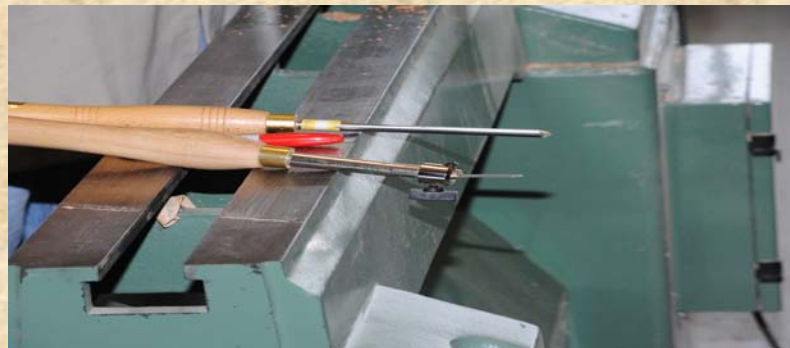

Wayne's technique included turning the top starting at the largest end first and applying the chatter tool for design. He then followed this up with the addition of his colors.

Once the colors were added to his liking, Wayne proceeded to turn the remaining body of the spinning top and its handle. He also applied the chatter tool design and colors before adding the finish.
